## ANCIENT ART - Prehistoric

Arch	A curved structural element that spans an opening.	
Corbel	it. Two such walls, meeting at the topmost row, create a corbeled arch or corbelled vault.	
Cromlech	A circle of monoliths. Also called henge.	
Lintel	A beam used to span an opening	
Megalith	A large, roughly hewn stone used in the construction of monumental prehistoric structures.	
Mesolithic	The "middle" Stone Age, between Paleolithic and the Neolithic ages.	
Monoliths	A large, single block or piece of stone used in megalithic structures.	
Neolithic	The "new" Stone Age.	
Paleolithic	The "old" Stone Age, during which humankind produced the first sculptures and paintings.	
Post-and-lintel system	A system of construction in which two posts support a lintel.	
Vault	A masonry roof or ceiling constructed on an arch principle.
